

The *KulturparlamentSoeste.V.* is awarding the Wilhelm-Morgner-scholarship for the field of visual arts for the second half of the year 2018.

The residential grant will be awarded to an artist holding a level of education equivalent to completed university studies.

Applicants need to be no more than 35 years old or have completed their studies no more than five years ago.

Free accommodation will be granted in Künstlerhaus 7a in the heart of the historical old town of Soest for the duration of six months. Additionally, a monthly stipend of 1.000€ will be granted.

Two artists who apply together will be housed together for a period of 4 months.

They will be granted a monthly stipend of 1.500€. At the end of their working scholarship, the scholar can exhibit his work in a final exhibition in the art museum of the city, the Museum Wilhelm Morgner.

The catalogue for the exhibition will be financed by the *KulturparlamentSoeste.V.*
